

Classroom Activities

Nursery: play time Topic : "Rubber Band Fishing"

To develop fine motor skills, eye-hand coordination and concentration Nursery teachers conducted a play time where the teacher introduced the game and showed children how to play rubber band fishing game.

Kids took the rubber band using pencil (catch it) by hooking it from the water tray and placed it in another tray and enjoyed the game with lots of learning in the team.

Nursery: 23 to 27 September Pre Math concept – Up & Down

To understand the pre math concept of "Up and Down" the teacher introduced it through hands-on activities and using simple language and gestures.

Teacher demonstrated it by raising hands "up" and "down" and singing the song like Rolly polly, roly polly, up, up, up.....



The teacher takes the students on a nature walk around the school playground. The teacher encouraged them to say "up" as they climbed and "down" as they slide.

These activities help students grasp the concepts of "up" and "down" through interactive observation, physical play, a fun rhyme, and creative expression, making the learning process enjoyable and memorable.





Aim:

To identify the regions of apical, lateral, and intercalary meristem in plants by observing their location and growth.



Activity Description:

Students carefully observed different parts of plants to understand how growth takes place:

- **Apical Meristem** at the tips of shoots and roots, responsible for the increase in plant height.
- **Lateral Meristem** along the sides of stems, contributing to the thickening of stems.
- **Intercalary Meristem** at the base of leaves or internodes, common in grasses, helping in rapid growth.

Through this observation-based activity, students not only learned where and how plants grow but also sharpened their scientific observation skills. The activity offered them a deeper appreciation of the hidden processes that make plants flourish all around us.



The session concluded with a class test, reinforcing the concept effectively.




